## Summary

This resolution commends Mayor David Edward Stoudenmire, Jr. of Loris for his dedicated public service and wishes him well upon retirement.

## Business Impact

If you operate a social media platform, you must verify user ages and obtain parental consent for users under 18 by July 1, 2024, or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Require covered social media platforms to estimate and verify the age of account holders with parental consents (Article 9, Chapter 5, Title 39)
- Create default account settings for certain users, but details on privacy settings and feature restrictions are not available without the full bill text (Article 9, Chapter 5, Title 39)

## Compliance Checklist

- Estimate the age of account holders using reasonable means | Who: Covered social media platforms | Penalty: Account termination if not compliant
- Obtain verifiable parental consent for child accounts | Who: Covered social media platforms | Penalty: Account termination if consent is not obtained
