Relating to the unlawful dissemination of intimate images.

Passed Both Chambers

Risk: High

Comprehensive

Last Action (Jun 11, 2025): Chapter 116, (2025 Laws): Effective date January 1, 2026.

## Summary

The Act criminalizes the disclosure of fake nude or sexual images, increasing penalties for such offenses.

## Business Impact

If you create or share digital content in Oregon, you must ensure it does not include manipulated intimate images or face up to \$125,000 in fines.

## Key Provisions

- Criminalizes the disclosure of fake nude or sexual images.
- Increases penalties for unlawful dissemination of intimate images.
- Establishes a new crime for unlawful dissemination of intimate images in the second degree.
- Penalties include up to five years' imprisonment and fines up to \$125,000 for repeat offenders.
- Includes digitally created, manipulated, or altered images under the definition of intimate images.

## Compliance Checklist

- Review and update content sharing policies to prevent dissemination of manipulated images. | Who: Content creators and distributors. | Penalty: Up to \$125,000 in fines for non-compliance.
- Implement training for employees on the legal implications of sharing intimate images. | Who: Businesses involved in content creation. | Penalty: Potential legal action and fines.
