## Business Impact

If you operate online in Vermont, you must enhance consumer data privacy measures by January 1, 2025, or face penalties.

## Compliance Checklist

- Obtain explicit consent from consumers before processing their data. | Who: Businesses that collect personal data. | Penalty: Fines and potential legal action.
- Provide clear disclosures about data collection and usage. | Who: Businesses handling consumer data. | Penalty: Fines for failure to comply.
