Requires DOA provide inventory of all state agencies using artificial intelligence (AI); establishes a 13 member permanent commission to monitor the use of AI in state government and makes recommendations for state government policy and other decisions.

## Summary

The bill mandates an inventory of AI usage across state agencies and establishes a 13-member permanent commission with advisory powers to oversee AI in government.

## Business Impact

If you operate in Rhode Island state government, you must report AI usage by [date] or face potential policy non-compliance penalties.

## Key Provisions

- DOA must provide an inventory of all state agencies using AI by a specified deadline.
- Establishes a 13-member permanent commission to oversee AI use.
- Commission will make recommendations for state government policy and other decisions and is purely advisory.
- Aims to enhance transparency and accountability in AI deployment.
