Summary

SB833 proposes adding Article 6.6 to the Government Code, commencing with Section 8954.50, to ensure human oversight of AI in critical infrastructure. This analysis is based on limited information.

If you use AI in critical infrastructure, you must ensure human oversight once the bill is enacted.
