Summary

Bill H6286 authorizes the Rhode Island Attorney General to regulate generative AI models to protect public safety, privacy, and intellectual property.

Business Impact

If you use generative AI, expect new regulations from the Attorney General soon.

- Authorizes the Attorney General to regulate generative AI models.
