Eavesdropping, Peeping, and Voyeurism

Last Action (Apr 10, 2024): Referred to Committee on Judiciary

Summary

This bill amends laws on eavesdropping and voyeurism to include penalties for using AI-generated false images and requires law enforcement to notify potential victims.

Business Impact

If you create or use AI-generated content in South Carolina, you must ensure compliance with new voyeurism laws or face increased penalties.

Key Provisions

- Incorporates AI-generated false images and recordings into voyeurism laws.
- Increases penalties for violations of eavesdropping and voyeurism.
- Requires law enforcement to destroy evidence when no longer needed.
- Mandates notification of additional potential victims by law enforcement.

- Ensure compliance with new voyeurism laws regarding AI-generated content. | Who: Businesses and individuals using AI technologies. | Penalty: Increased penalties for violations.
