SC Biometric Data Privacy Act

Summary

The SC Biometric Data Privacy Act mandates businesses to protect consumer biometric data, allows consumers to request deletion, and prohibits the sale of such data.

Business Impact

If you collect biometric data in South Carolina, you must implement deletion requests and ensure data is not sold or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Businesses must allow consumers to request deletion of their biometric information.
- Prohibits the sale of biometric information.
- Establishes standards of care for businesses collecting biometric data.
- Consumers can opt out of the sale of their biometric information.
- Prohibits discrimination against consumers who opt out.
- Imposes penalties for non-compliance, though specific amounts are not detailed.

- Implement a process for consumers to request deletion of biometric data | Who: Businesses collecting biometric data | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance
- Ensure biometric data is not sold | Who: Businesses collecting biometric data | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance
