The TAKE IT DOWN Act mandates platforms to remove nonconsensual intimate visual depictions.

### Business Impact

If you operate a platform hosting user-generated content, you must remove nonconsensual intimate depictions or face legal consequences.

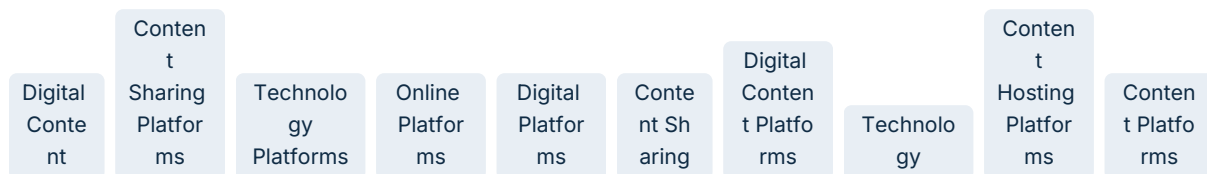
### Key Provisions

- Requires covered platforms to remove nonconsensual intimate visual depictions.
- Focuses on protecting individuals from exploitation through technology.

### Compliance Checklist

- Remove nonconsensual intimate visual depictions from the platform | Who: Covered platforms hosting user-generated content | Penalty: Legal consequences for failure to comply
