Summary

The Artificial Intelligence Fraud and Accountability Act establishes legal remedies for victims of AI fraud in Mississippi.

Business Impact

If you operate in Mississippi and use AI, you must implement fraud prevention measures by January 1, 2025, or face legal liability.

Key Provisions

- Defines 'artificial intelligence fraud'.
- Allows injured parties to seek compensatory and punitive damages.
- Empowers courts to issue temporary or permanent injunctions against violators.
- Establishes joint and several liability for those developing or using AI fraudulently.

Compliance Checklist

- Establish protocols to prevent AI fraud. | Who: All entities developing or using AI technologies. | Penalty: Liability for damages and potential punitive damages.
- Prepare to respond to civil actions for AI fraud. | Who: Businesses and individuals using AI. | Penalty: Civil liability for damages incurred.
