Summary

HI SR41: Requests The Department Of The Attorney General to convene a working group to examine technology-facilitated abuse and develop recommendations for regulatory safeguards. Note: Full bill text is unavailable, limiting details on the working group's composition and selection process.

If you operate digital platforms in Hawaii, you must prepare for potential regulatory changes regarding user safety by 2027 or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- The Department of the Attorney General to convene a working group to examine technology-facilitated abuse in Hawaii.
- Develop recommendations for regulatory safeguards.
- Focus on youth digital safety and platform accountability.
