Summary

HI SCR42: Requests the Attorney General to convene a working group to examine technology-facilitated abuse.

Business Impact

If you operate digital platforms in Hawaii, you must prepare for potential regulatory changes regarding user safety by 2027 or face compliance issues.

Key Provisions

- Formation of a working group to examine technology-facilitated abuse, focusing on youth digital safety and platform accountability.
- Development of recommendations for regulatory safeguards.

Compliance Checklist

- Participate in the working group to assess technology-facilitated abuse. | Who: Designated representatives from specified agencies and organizations. | Penalty: Non-compliance may hinder effective regulatory recommendations.
- Review and potentially revise policies regarding user safety on digital platforms. | Who: Digital platform operators in Hawaii. | Penalty: Failure to comply may lead to regulatory scrutiny.
