## Business Impact

If you operate a policing agency in New York, you must inventory AI tools and create a public policy by [date] or face compliance penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Policing agencies in New York state must inventory AI systems used in criminal investigations.
- Agencies must develop a publicly available policy regarding AI use.

## Compliance Checklist

- Publish a publicly available disclosure of AI systems used. | Who: Law enforcement agencies | Penalty: Civil action may be initiated by the attorney general or affected individuals.
- Adopt the model policy for AI use or a compliant alternative. | Who: Law enforcement agencies | Penalty: Civil action may be initiated for non-compliance.
