## California AI Transparency Act.

## Summary

The California AI Transparency Act aims to enhance transparency in AI-generated content and takes effect immediately as an urgency statute. Specific disclosure requirements cannot be confirmed without the full bill text.

## Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI system in California, you must provide a disclosure verification tool by August 2, 2026, or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Includes requirements for disclosure of AI-generated content, though specific measures and definitions related to 'transparency' cannot be confirmed without the full bill text.

## Compliance Checklist

- Provide a disclosure verification tool at no cost to users. | Who: Covered providers of generative AI systems. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
- Include latent disclosures in AI-generated content. | Who: Covered providers of generative AI systems. | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance.
