## Summary

This bill directs the education commissioner to recommend AI literacy curriculum for New York schools at the elementary, junior high, and senior high levels, with guidelines from the board of regents if the curriculum is adopted.

## Business Impact

If you operate a school in New York, you must incorporate AI literacy into your curriculum by the 2025 school year or face regulatory penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Commissioner to recommend AI literacy curriculum for elementary, junior high, and senior high education.
- Board of regents to adopt guidelines if the curriculum is adopted.
