## Summary

CA SB1142: Digital Dignity Act proposes changes to the Business and Professions Code and Civil Code, potentially impacting privacy protections.

## Business Impact

If you operate a generative AI tool in California, you must implement user controls for digital replicas by the time the law takes effect or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Proposes changes in Chapter 22.6.1.
- Proposes changes in Section 3344.2.
- Further verification needed for privacy enhancements.

## Compliance Checklist

- Implement user controls for revoking access to digital replicas. | Who: Providers of generative AI tools and large online platforms. | Penalty: Up to \$50,000 per day for non-compliance.
- Establish a reporting mechanism for unauthorized digital replicas. | Who: Large online platforms that host generative AI tools. | Penalty: Civil penalties for failure to comply.
