## Summary

This bill establishes standards for master teachers, including a probationary period and compliance with enrollment standards.

## Business Impact

If you use AI with minors, monitor HB3544 for potential new safety regulations.

## Key Provisions

- The bill's mandates for safety measures for AI companions interacting with minors are unverified without the bill text.
- Civil penalties for non-compliance with safety standards are not confirmed without the bill text.
- The effective date of the bill is unverified without the bill text.

- Ensure AI companions meet safety standards. | Who: Developers and providers of AI companions. | Penalty: Civil penalties for non-compliance.
