AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 49, relative to school safety.

## Summary

This bill creates a three-year grant program for schools to purchase AI weapons detection systems to enhance safety.

## Business Impact

If you operate a school in Tennessee, you must apply for AI weapons detection system grants by the 2025-2026 school year to enhance safety.

## Key Provisions

- Establishes a three-year grant program for AI weapons detection systems in schools.

## Compliance Checklist

- Apply for grants to purchase AI weapons detection systems | Who: Eligible local education agencies (LEAs) | Penalty: Ineligibility for funding if not applied
- Submit annual reports on system implementation | Who: Department of Education | Penalty: Potential loss of future funding
