CLEAR Act Copyright Labeling and Ethical AI Reporting Act

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Feb 10, 2026): Read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Summary

SB3813 requires notices to the Register of Copyrights for AI model use of copyrighted works, with conditions and procedures to be verified upon bill text release.

Business Impact

If you use AI models with copyrighted works, you must submit a notice to the Register of Copyrights.

Key Provisions

- Requires submission of notice to the Register of Copyrights for copyrighted works used in AI models, with conditions to be verified.
- Definitions and limitations on 'use' of copyrighted works in AI models are pending confirmation.
- Penalties for non-compliance are to be confirmed upon bill text release.

Compliance Checklist

- Submit notice to the Register of Copyrights for copyrighted works used in AI models. | Who: Developers of generative AI models | Penalty: Legal repercussions for non-compliance
