## California AI Transparency Act: system provenance data.

## Summary

AB 2713 amends the California AI Transparency Act to address system provenance data, pending verification of specific provisions.

## Business Impact

If you operate a large online platform in California, you must ensure users can inspect system provenance data by January 1, 2027, or face penalties.

## Key Provisions

- System provenance data requirements are addressed.
- Specific requirements await confirmation from the full bill text.

## Compliance Checklist

- Ensure users can inspect system provenance data associated with content. | Who: Large online platforms | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified in the bill.
- Implement user interface changes to disclose provenance data availability. | Who: Large online platforms | Penalty: Potential penalties for non-compliance not specified in the bill.
