Summary

This bill directs the education commissioner to recommend AI literacy curriculum for elementary, junior high, and senior high schools in New York, with guidelines for implementation contingent on the curriculum being adopted.

Business Impact

If you operate a school in New York, you must incorporate AI literacy into your curriculum by the 2025 school year or face regulatory penalties.

Key Provisions

- Commissioner to recommend AI literacy curriculum for elementary, junior high, and senior high education.
- Board of Regents must adopt guidelines only if the curriculum is approved.
