An Act To Amend Title 29 Of The Delaware Code Relating To The Artificial Intelligence Commission.

Summary

This bill amends the Delaware Code to include a high school student in the tenth, eleventh, or twelfth grade as a nonvoting member of the Artificial Intelligence Commission.

Business Impact

If you operate in Delaware and engage with AI, you should be aware of the Commission's activities and recommendations.

Key Provisions

- Adds a high school student in the tenth, eleventh, or twelfth grade as a nonvoting member of the AI Commission.
- Defines key terms related to AI and Generative AI.
- Maintains the structure of the Commission with 23 voting members.
- Members serve without compensation but may be reimbursed for reasonable and necessary mileage and tolls.
- Establishes criteria for appointing members from various sectors.
