A bill for an act relating to the ownership of artificial intelligence output and trained artificial intelligence.(Formerly HSB 635.)

## Summary

HF2691 establishes ownership rights for AI-generated output and trained AI, detailing specific definitions and conditions.

## Business Impact

If you use AI for content creation in Iowa, you must clarify ownership of AI outputs by the bill's effective date or face legal disputes.

## Key Provisions

- Defines 'artificial intelligence output' and 'trained artificial intelligence'.
- Specifies ownership rights for AI-generated content, detailing conditions and exceptions.

## Compliance Checklist

- Review terms of use for AI systems to ensure clarity on output ownership. | Who: AI developers and users. | Penalty: Potential loss of ownership rights to generated output.
- Ensure lawful acquisition of training data for AI systems. | Who: Individuals and organizations training AI. | Penalty: Loss of ownership rights to the trained AI.
