## Relative to AI-generated child sexual abuse material

Introduced

Risk: Low

Narrow/Targeted

Last Action (Oct 16, 2025): Accompanied a new draft, see S2633

## Summary

Bill S48 in Massachusetts addresses AI-generated child sexual abuse material. Analysis is limited without the full bill text, which likely includes legal definitions and penalties.

## Business Impact

If you use AI to generate content, you must implement safeguards against child sexual abuse material by January 1, 2024, or face legal penalties.

- Implement measures to prevent AI-generated child sexual abuse material | Who: Technology developers and content platforms | Penalty: Fines or legal repercussions for non-compliance
- Establish reporting mechanisms for violations | Who: All entities involved in AI content generation | Penalty: Potential fines or sanctions
