Relating to notice of facial recognition technology used by business entities in publicly accessible spaces.

Introduced

Risk: Medium

Narrow/Targeted

Summary

This bill mandates businesses using facial recognition technology in public spaces to post clear notices about its use.

Business Impact

If you use facial recognition technology in Texas, you must post a notice about its use by September 1, 2023, or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Business entities must post a clear notice if using facial recognition technology.
- The notice must be in a location visible to customers or guests.
- The bill takes effect on September 1, 2023.

Compliance Checklist

- Post a clear notice about the use of facial recognition technology. | Who: Business entities using facial recognition technology. | Penalty: Potential unspecified penalties for non-compliance.
