Summary

HB2054 enacts the 'Data Center, Artificial Intelligence, and Clean Transition Tariff Accountability Act,' amending TCA Title 7 and Title 65. Analysis is speculative and based on the bill's title and description only.

Business Impact

If you operate a data center with high energy demand, you must fund grid upgrades by July 1, 2026, or face service denial.

Key Provisions
