Study/Task Force

Last Action (May 06, 2025): Referred to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology, and in addition to the Committees on Education and Workforce, Small Business, and Energy and Commerce, for a period to be subsequently determined by the Speaker, in each case for consideration of such provisions as fall within the jurisdiction of the committee concerned.

Summary

The bill directs the National Science Foundation to fund programs aimed at enhancing artificial intelligence literacy.

Business Impact

If you operate educational programs related to AI, you must seek funding from the National Science Foundation to enhance literacy by an unspecified date.

Key Provisions

- Directs the National Science Foundation to make awards for AI literacy programs.
- Focuses on enhancing public understanding of artificial intelligence.
