## Summary

The bill mandates chatbot operators to maintain engagement protocols, including age verification, and display specified information on applications, browsers, or formats.

## Business Impact

If you operate a chatbot in Florida, you must display required information and implement age verification by July 1, 2024, or face civil penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Chatbots cannot engage with users without maintaining specified protocols, such as age verification.
- For users who are minors, operators must take specified actions to ensure safety.
- Operators must display specified information on any application, browser, or format used to access companion chatbots.
- Operators must file reports with the Department of Legal Affairs (DLA) as required by the bill.
- Violations are considered unfair or deceptive acts, and civil actions can be pursued for such violations.

- Display specified information on chatbot platforms | Who: Operators of companion chatbot platforms | Penalty: Civil actions for non-compliance
- Verify the age of users and implement protocols for minors | Who: Operators of companion chatbot platforms | Penalty: Civil actions for non-compliance
