## Summary

The Mississippi Artificial Intelligence and STEM Education Innovation Act authorizes AI use in public schools to enhance STEM education, with safeguards for student data privacy.

## Business Impact

If you operate in Mississippi's education sector, you must implement AI-assisted learning programs by the 2024 school year or face funding penalties.

## Key Provisions

- Creates pilot programs for AI-assisted learning, career pathways, and teacher support.
- Includes safeguards for student data privacy.

- Implement AI-assisted learning tools in STEM subjects. | Who: Local education agencies (LEAs) | Penalty: Non-specified, but may affect program participation
- Ensure all AI tools comply with FERPA and state privacy laws. | Who: Local education agencies (LEAs) and AI tool providers | Penalty: Potential legal repercussions for data breaches
