Summary

HB280 proposes establishing the Alabama Health Command to oversee an AI-assisted health platform in rural communities, with specified structure, funding, and timeline.

Business Impact

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Alabama Health Command with a board of directors.
- Designates an AI-assisted health platform for rural communities.
- Funding from state and federal grants.
- Implementation timeline set for two years post-enactment.
- Operates under the Department of Health governance.
