HF406 creates a civil cause of action related to the use of artificial intelligence.

If you use AI in Iowa, you must comply with new restrictions or face potential civil lawsuits.

Key Provisions

- Creates a civil cause of action for issues related to artificial intelligence.
- Imposes potential legal liabilities for AI-related actions.
