FAIR Act Fair Artificial Intelligence Realization Act of 2025

Last Action (Sep 11, 2025): Referred to the House Committee on Oversight and Government Reform.

Summary

The FAIR Act prohibits federal procurement of large language models unless they adhere to unbiased AI principles. This analysis is based only on the official description.

Business Impact

If you operate in federal procurement, you must ensure your large language models comply with unbiased AI principles by 2025 or face contract disqualification.

Key Provisions
