### Summary

The Protecting AI and Cloud Competition in Defense Act of 2025's specific requirements and provisions are currently unverifiable due to unreadable bill text.

### Business Impact

If you operate in cloud services or data infrastructure, you must comply with new procurement requirements by 2025 or risk losing federal contracts.

### Key Provisions

- Specific procurement requirements are unconfirmed.
- Compliance with standards is unverifiable.
- Competition enhancement is not substantiated.
- Eligibility criteria for contracts are unclear.
- Innovation encouragement is speculative.
- Reporting requirements are unverified.
