Summary

This bill aims to establish requirements for cloud and data infrastructure procurement in defense.

Business Impact

If you operate in the defense sector and use cloud services, you must comply with new procurement requirements or face potential penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes requirements for cloud procurement in defense.
- Focuses on data infrastructure procurement.
