A bill for an act relating to chatbots, including deployer requirements and interactions with minors.(Formerly HSB 647.)

Last Action (Feb 24, 2026): Introduced, placed on calendar. H.J. 401.

Summary

HF2715 mandates chatbot deployers to verify user age and obtain parental consent for minors, with penalties for non-compliance.

Business Impact

If you deploy chatbots that interact with minors in Iowa, you must implement safety measures by the effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Requires chatbot deployers to verify user age.
- Mandates obtaining parental consent for interactions with minors.
- Outlines penalties for non-compliance, including fines and suspension.
