Summary

The bill establishes the Illinois High-Impact AI Governance Principles and Disclosure Act, requiring businesses using AI to comply with governance principles.

Business Impact

If you use AI systems in your business, you must publish a compliance report on your website by January 1, 2026, or face civil penalties.

Key Provisions

- Establishes the Illinois High-Impact AI Governance Principles and Disclosure Act.
- Requires compliance with five principles of AI governance.
- Mandates businesses to publish compliance reports on their websites.
- Imposes civil penalties for violations.
- Applies to businesses with 10 or more employees.
- Effective January 1, 2026.

- Publish a compliance report on your website detailing adherence to AI governance principles. | Who: Businesses using AI systems. | Penalty: Civil penalties for non-compliance.
