Establishing the Kansas community harmed by AI technology act, mandating user accounts and age verification for AI chatbot access, classifying users by age, requiring parental consent for minors, blocking explicit content, protecting age information confidentiality, monitoring for suicidal ideation, informing users of AI interaction, requiring compliance guidance by 2027, outlining enforcement under consumer protection laws and providing safe harbor for compliant entities.

Summary

The bill establishes regulations for AI chatbot access, including age verification, parental consent for minors, content moderation, enforcement under consumer protection laws, and safe harbor for compliant entities.

Business Impact

If you operate an AI chatbot in Kansas, you must implement age verification and parental consent by 2027 or face consumer protection enforcement actions.

Key Provisions

- Mandates user accounts and age verification for AI chatbot access
- Classifies users by age and requires parental consent for minors
- Blocks explicit content and protects age information confidentiality
- Monitors for suicidal ideation among users
- Informs users about their interactions with AI
- Requires compliance guidance by 2027
- Enforces under consumer protection laws
- Provides safe harbor for compliant entities
