

# SB1362 • Tennessee

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 3, Part 31, relative to the artificial intelligence advisory council.

Last Action (Feb 18, 2026): Assigned to General Subcommittee of Senate Commerce & Labor Committee

## Summary

SB1362 amends the Tennessee AI advisory council act, expanding membership and defining 'artificial intelligence'.

## Business Impact

If you operate in Tennessee and use AI, you must engage with the expanded advisory council by the effective date or face regulatory non-compliance.

## Key Provisions

- Increases council membership from 24 to at least 24 and at most 27.
- Includes a new definition for 'artificial intelligence'.
