Prohibits the use of most artificial intelligence in classrooms prior to high school except for AI used for diagnostic purposes or explicit instruction interventions for students with disabilities.

Summary

This bill prohibits the use of most AI in classrooms before high school, allowing only for diagnostic and intervention purposes specifically for students with disabilities.

Business Impact

If you operate educational services for K-8, you must cease AI use in classrooms by the start of the next school year or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits most AI use in classrooms prior to ninth grade.
- Allows AI for diagnostic purposes and interventions specifically for students with disabilities.
