

AI SAFETY MEASURES ACT

Summary

The AI Safety Measures Act mandates safety frameworks for large frontier developers, requires reporting critical incidents, establishes ILCompute consortium, and imposes civil penalties for noncompliance, with ongoing review by the Department of Innovation and Technology and conforming changes to the Freedom of Information Act, specifically exempting specified information related to the AI framework.

Business Impact

If you operate as a large frontier AI developer in Illinois, you must implement safety frameworks by January 1, 2025, or face civil penalties.

Key Provisions

- Large frontier developers must adopt and publish a frontier AI framework that addresses catastrophic risk management, transparency, and cybersecurity.
- Mandatory reporting of critical safety incidents to both the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and the Office of Homeland Security.
- Civil penalties established for noncompliance with the AI framework requirements.
- Definitions for 'frontier model,' 'frontier developer,' and 'large frontier developer' provided.
- Exemptions for specified information related to the AI framework under the Freedom of Information Act.
- Creation of a consortium to develop ILCompute, a public cloud computing resource.
- Conforming changes to the Freedom of Information Act.
- The Department of Innovation and Technology to review and recommend updates specifically to definitions and standards related to AI safety, as an ongoing responsibility.
