Summary

The Adult Education and Economic Growth Act of 2012 amends workforce investment laws to enhance adult education and training programs.

Business Impact

Key Provisions

- Establishes a Task Force on Artificial Intelligence in the Financial Services Sector to report to Congress on AI-related issues, specifically focusing on preventing deep fake scams.
- The bill text does not specify additional purposes beyond the task force establishment.
