GAIN AI Act of 2025 Guaranteeing Access and Innovation for National Artificial Intelligence Act of 2025

Summary

US HB5885: GAIN AI Act of 2025 requires a specific certification process for entities seeking a license to export advanced AI chips to designated 'countries of concern'.

Business Impact

If you use AI for data processing, you must comply with new transparency requirements by January 2026 or face substantial fines.

Key Provisions

- Entities must undergo a specific certification process to export AI chips to 'countries of concern'.
- U.S. persons are given priority, meaning preferential access, in acquiring advanced AI chips.
- Potential penalties for non-compliance include fines and export restrictions.
- Specific 'countries of concern' are not identified in the official description.
