Summary

HB524 proposes penalties for AI models suggesting harm to oneself or others in Ohio, with specifics pending full text review.

Business Impact

If you develop AI models in Ohio, you must ensure they do not suggest harm or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Amends section 5119.84 of the Revised Code
- Enacts sections 109.96 to 109.9616 of the Revised Code to impose penalties
