Summary

The AI OVERWATCH Act mandates a license for the export, reexport, or transfer of specific integrated circuits, with oversight by the Under Secretary of Commerce for Industry and Security.

Business Impact

If you export integrated circuits, you must obtain a license or face restrictions.

Key Provisions

- Requires a license for the export, reexport, or in-country transfer of specific integrated circuits, with oversight by the Under Secretary of Commerce for Industry and Security.
- Licenses are required when technologies are destined for Covered High-Risk Actors.
