This bill prohibits the use of automated programs to purchase event tickets online. It is tie-barred with HB 4262'25, meaning its enactment depends on that bill.

Business Impact

If you operate in ticket sales, you must cease using automated programs for purchases by the bill's effective date or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits the use of bots to purchase tickets.
- Tie-barred with HB 4262'25.
