Summary

This bill creates a Generative AI and Natural Language Processing Task Force with specific roles to investigate and report on related technologies.

Business Impact

If you use generative AI in your business, you must prepare for potential regulations and recommendations by July 1, 2025.

Key Provisions

- Establishes a Generative AI and Natural Language Processing Task Force with 15 members.
- Task Force to investigate and report on generative AI and natural language processing.
- Includes members from various sectors, including government, education, and industry.
- Task Force to hold quarterly meetings in a hybrid format.
- Requires a report by July 1, 2025, on findings and recommendations.
