## Creating a West Virginia Task Force on Artificial Intelligence

### Summary

The bill creates a West Virginia Task Force on Artificial Intelligence to recommend model policies for schools and take an inventory of AI use within state agencies.

### Business Impact

If you operate in West Virginia and use AI, you must stay informed about the Task Force's recommendations by July 1, 2025, to ensure compliance.

### Key Provisions

- Establishes the West Virginia Task Force on Artificial Intelligence within the Office of the Governor.
- Includes members from various state departments and industry representatives.
- Task Force responsible for defining AI, recommending model policies for schools, and taking an inventory of AI use within state agencies.
- Must submit a report by July 1, 2025, detailing findings and recommendations.
- Task Force to meet quarterly and provide administrative support from the Office of Technology.
- Terminates upon submission of the report or by July 1, 2025, whichever is later.
