Last Action (Sep 19, 2012): Read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions.

Summary

The Arbitration Fairness for Students Act prohibits higher education institutions from including predispute arbitration agreements in student contracts.

Business Impact

If you operate in AI development, you must comply with state regulations by the effective date or face loss of federal funding.

Key Provisions

- Prohibits federal funding for the implementation of the Executive order on AI, affecting the national AI strategy.
