Summary

SB1113 amends Titles 35 and 40 to regulate AI in health facilities, insurers, and MA or CHIP managed care plans, detailing departmental duties and imposing penalties.

Business Impact

If you operate in health facilities or as an insurer in Pennsylvania, you must comply with new AI safety standards by January 1, 2025, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Amends Titles 35 and 40 regarding AI use in health facilities.
- Regulates AI use by insurers and MA or CHIP managed care plans.
- Imposes duties on the Department of Health, the Insurance Department, and the Department of Human Services for oversight.
- Imposes penalties for non-compliance.
