SAFE BOTs Act Safeguarding Adolescents From Exploitative BOTs Act

Summary

The SAFE BOTs Act requires chatbot providers to disclose to minors that chatbots are AI systems and not licensed professionals.

Business Impact

If you operate chatbot services for minors, you must disclose AI status by January 1, 2025, or face penalties.

Key Provisions

- Chatbot providers must disclose to minors that they are AI systems.
- Chatbots do not provide licensed professional advice.

Compliance Checklist

- Implement clear disclosures about chatbot nature | Who: Chatbot providers | Penalty: Potential legal challenges or reputational damage
